2015 STABLING POLICY

Stalls are sold on a first come, first served basis. Please remember, we order stalls based on the reservations we have received 2 weeks prior to the horse show. While we may have a limited number of stalls available on short notice, we cannot guarantee stabling requests received the week of the show. 2015 HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS

*new for 2015 the office will have specified hours. Please plan your trips to the office accordingly. Thursdays: 9:00 am until 6:00 pm
Show Days: 7:00 am until 6:00 pm
Sunday: 1 hour after the horse show finishes.

2015 SCHOOLING SCHEDULE

Thursday (weather permitting) Ring 1: 10:00am-2:00pm open for schooling 2:00pm-3:00pm closed for maintenance 3:00pm-7:00pm* open for schooling

Ring 2 (jumps in ring two may not be set higher than 2'6"): 12:00noon-3:30pm open for schooling 3:30 – 4:00 closed for maintenance 4:00pm-7:00*pm open for schooling

Friday (weather permitting): Ring 1: Flatwork only until 7:30am

Ring 2 (jumps may not be set higher than 2'6"): 10am-7pm* open for schooling. There will be a 1 hour break for ring maintenance.

Saturday and Sunday:

Flatwork only in both rings until 1/2 hour before the start of the show. *PLEASE NOTE THE 7:00pm CLOSING OF THE SHOW RINGS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. THE INDOOR ARENA OR SCHOOLING AREAS ARE AVAILABLE FOR RIDING AFTER 7:00 PM.

2015 ENTRY POLICY

Entries Close the Thursday before each show at 3:00 pm. All entries received after the deadline will be charged a one-time late fee of \$20. Entries submitted online prior to 8:00 pm Thursday will not incur a late fee. Please submit your entries early via mail or online to avoid the late fee.

2015 Add/Scratch Policy

This year, **same day adds** will only be allowed up until the start of a class at a fee of **\$5 per class**. To avoid the same day add fee, adds must be completed in the office before closing time, or online before 8:00 pm the day before the class. There will be no fee for scratching a class before it starts. Rode did not enter (RDNE) fees of \$25 per occurrence will be charged to horses showing in a class that they have not entered. *Per USEF rules, horses showing in a class in which they were not properly entered before the start of the class are ineligible for an award in that class.*
